- 1. Inquiry From Two Rivers Gianforte called to inquire if there were any changes in the area of Tinton Woods since the total gallonage figures took an unusual drop Richard is going to look into the matter to make sure there is not a problem. He also expressed concerns about the Fort Monmouth redevelopment plans as they relate to sewerage service; I discussed the matter with the Mayor (who serves on the Board) and he agreed that the service is to be rebuilt by the developers. Finally Gianforte said he wanted us to "redirect" the flow that comes out of the Howard Commons / Golf Course area and goes through a Tinton Falls pipe to get to Two Rivers. I will be working with our engineer on this issue.
