SUMP PUMPS

Each year millions of gallons of storm water improperly drain into Eatontown sanitary sewers. This contributes to overloading the sanitary sewer system, which may cause back-ups into Eatontown residents' basements. Studies have shown much of this problem comes from sump pumps which improperly discharge into laundry tubs, floor drains, or through other connections to the sanitary sewer.

Besides costing thousands of extra dollars in sewerage processing fees, these hook-ups are illegal. If you have a sump pump and are not sure whether it is hooked up properly, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority will gladly inspect your premises (with complete amnesty if it is an illegal connection).
