A. Current Month Activities:

- A1 224 Know Avenue, Block 3301, Lot 1; installed a new cleanout riser and cast iron sewer box at the curb area for access to inspect and televise the sanitary sewer lateral to the main line in the street. Discovered root intrusions in the street approximately 10' from the curb.
- A2 Old Orchard, Circle, Country Club and Wampum Park pumping stations; vacuumed and washed down the wetwells, cleaned the wetwell pump control transducers and floats.
- A3 Canon MX860 Printer Error Code U052; removed the cartridge holder, cleaned with isopropyl alcohol and flushed with water, air dry and reinstall the ink cartages. This printer has been replaced with a Canon MF247dw.
- A4 Old Orchard Pumping Station; installed a Delonghi 1500 watt tower ceramic heater in the generator enclosure for the Dialog alarm cold weather operations.
- A5 Pumping Stations; worked on the Generator/Enclosure/By-pass Chamber cleaning and preventative maintenance program.
- A6 Maintenance Garage; checked all the fluid levels and exercised all of the small engine and emergency equipment.
- A7 Root Treatment Program; installed Root-X herbicide foaming agent in (39) ESA customer sanitary sewer service laterals to treat the pipe from the cleanout at the curb area to the main line in the street for root intrusions.
- A8 112 Oak Lane; installed a repair cap for the cleanout damaged by a snow blower in the sidewalk.

B1 - Brookwood Pumping Station; T.R. Weniger worked with Raymond Cornetto, Jamie Newgarde of Reiner Pump Systems and the ESA personnel on making the final connections for testing of the new pumps with fresh water draw down and performance evaluation.

- C5 Maintenance Garage Parking Lot Improvement Project; Shore Top Construction Corp. has completed the installation of paving, curbing, crash bollards and storm drain work. Completion of the fence will be completed as weather permits.
