

Executive Director's Report – October 12, 2021

RE: Monthly Report – September / October 2021

- 1. Personal** – As a result of a long-planned vacation and personal days I was only in the office one week between meetings – that is why this is an abbreviated monthly report.
- 2. FMERA** – As discussed at the meeting FMERA has completely changed their approach to the sewer infrastructure on the main base area; T&M is preparing a proposal to do the engineering work but as of this writing (9-22) it has not yet been submitted.
- 3. Old Orchard Pump Station** – Shortly after the Board authorized the engineer to go out to bid on the project the owners submitted what they described as a schematic development plan for the property and a revised easement access plan. After discussing the matter with the consulting attorney, we decided to proceed with the bidding – we can discuss changing the access route to the pump station later.
- 4. Sun Eagles Area** – Two Rivers has prepared a proposed agreement covering the flow from Sun Eagles – I sent the proposal to our attorney for his review; I also sent it to the engineer for any comments he might have.
- 5. JCP&L Damage Tinton Ave.** – I have nothing new to report on this matter.
- 6. Borough Take Over** – We have not received anything new from the Borough since they requested the report on our debt status.
- 7. Authority Bylaws** - I have not had time to work on the bylaws – of course if the Borough is going to eliminate the Authority it would be a moot point not worth the effort.
