- 1. C-2 Training Classes Kevin and Chris are continuing to make progress in their "C-2" class they should be finished by the end of May and be able to take the exam in June of July.
- 2. Two Rivers Project Following last month's meeting Mike Gianforte provided a breakdown of the impact their Pleasure Bay project (which I sent out to members by email). It suggests the impact will be less than I feared but would still require an increase in our fees.
- 3. Officials Seminar The JIF seminar on risk reduction will be available online until May 1 so far 3 members (Brian, Ken and myself) have competed the course we receive a \$250 discount on our insurance bill for each competition.
- **4. State Assistance Plan –** We applied the state's check to the account of the resident who applied for assistance we then received another state check Michelle has been in contact with the state to understand what we are supposed to do with the new check.
- **5. Old Orchard Pump Station –** Work on the new station has been completed and it is in operation.
- **6. Old Orchard Easement –** The Commissioners have now sent in their bills given the unexpected cost involved in the settlement we probably will have to postpone some of our capital improvements until next year.
- 7. Sun Eagles Steve Schreiber is still trying to resolve the issue of the Parshall Flume he contacted the developer again on April 8, but we still have not received a reply. The developer also has not made any further payments on the connection fees.
- **8.** Howard Commons / Liberty Point I have nothing new to report on "contractor agreement".
- **9. Safety Repairs** The replacement of the stairs at Wampum and Circle Pump Stations has been completed.
- **10. Missing Easement –** We have a main behind the stores on Main Street near West Street, but no easement is shown on the tax map Michelle and the attorney are researching the matter.
